To be admitted, students need to be Economics Majors or have completed the equivalent of ACCT 100, ACCT 101, ECON 101, ECON 102, and DS 212/ECON 212 or MATH 124, all with grades of C- or better.

2. Students will learn about the basics of Bitcoin, smart contract platforms, and decentralized finance.
3. Students will learn soft communication skills by interviewing a financial professional.
