- To avoid taking additional units, it is recommended that you meet the SF State Studies (AERM, GP, ES, SJ) requirements within your GE or major.
- Consider taking a class combined with a laboratory or a separate lab to fulfill B3 if not already satisfied.

## Complementary Studies

Students completing a Bachelor of Arts in American Indian Studies must complete 12 units in Complementary Studies in courses bearing a prefix other than AIS or courses cross-listed with AIS. These units may be in:

- a. a language other than English;
- b. one course from AAS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/aa\_s/), AFRS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/afrs/), LTNS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/ltns/), and RRS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/rrs/);
- c. or four courses from one prefix: AAS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/aa\_s/) or AFRS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/afrs/) or LTNS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/ltns/) or RRS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/rrs/);
- d. partial completion of a minor or certificate;
- e. units earned in a study abroad program;
- f. or a coherent group of courses complementary to the major.

With the approval of an advisor in the major, courses which fulfill the complementary studies requirement may be lower- or upper-division units, resident, or transfer units.
