(Note: Students may not use an alternate prefix that is cross-listed with the primary prefix for the major.) Creative Writing majors will satisfy this requirement from within the major by taking 12 units of literature classes required in the major, which are recognized in the major list of any or all of the following prefixes: ENG (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/eng/), AFRS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/afrs/), CWL (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/cwl/), LTNS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/ltns/), WGS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/wgs/), HUM (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/hum/), AAS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/aa_s/), MGS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/mgs/), or AIS (http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/courses/ais/).

Students who have earned AA-T or AS-T degrees and are pursuing a similar B.A. degree at SF State are required to fulfill the Complementary Studies requirement as defined by the major department. Students should consult with a major advisor about how transfer units and/ or SF State units can best be applied to this requirement in order to ensure degree completion within 60 units.
